STATEMENT OF REASONS

Proposed Introduction No Waiting At Any Time Restrictions

Dowie Close, Barrow-in-Furness Ullswater Close, Dalton-in-Furness Hollygate Road, Dalton-in-Furness Kepplewray Drive, Barrow-in-Furness Larch Rise, Barrow-in-Furness Moor Tarn Lane, Barrow-in-Furness Dalton Lane, Barrow-in-Furness Ireleth Brow, Askam-in-Furness Windrush Crescent, Barrow-in-Furness Roose Road, Barrow-in-Furness Broughton Road, Dalton-in-Furness Ainslie Street, Dalton-in-Furness Crozier Close, Barrow-in-Furness Headland Rise, Barrow-in-Furness Parklands Drive, Askam-in-Furness New Road, Askam-in-Furness Ireleth Road, Askam-in-Furness Abbey Heights, Askam-in-Furness Cemetery Hill, Dalton-in-Furness Esthwaite Drive, Dalton-in-Furness Biggar Bank Road, Barrow-in-Furness Station Road, Dalton-in-Furness Station Approach, Dalton-in-Furness St Francis Gardens, Barrow-in-Furness Yarlside Road, Barrow-in-Furness Crellin Street, Barrow-in-Furness Marsh Street, Barrow-in-Furness Arthur Street and, Barrow-in-Furness Sutherland Street, Barrow-in-Furness

Following comments from residents, businesses, councillors and emergency services regarding parking causing obstruction and visibility issues we are proposing to introduce new 'No Waiting At Any Time' restrictions at the above locations, for the following reason set out in Section 1 Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984:-

(a) for avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the road or any other road or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising, and

(c) for facilitating the passage on the road or any other road of any class of traffic

(including pedestrians),

Proposing to remove part of Limited Waiting Parking Place (At All Times) 10 mins no return within one hour (permit holders exempt)" restriction on part and re-introduce the "No Waiting At Any Time" restriction

Crellin Street, Marsh Street, Arthur Street and Sutherland Street

Following new housing development, it is now necessary to remove the existing Limited Waiting Parking Place on part of Crellin Street, Marsh Street, and Sutherland Street in Barrow-in-Furness and replace it with a "No Waiting At Any Time" restriction to prevent parking obstruction in front of new driveways.

- (a) for avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the road or any other road or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising; and
- (b) for facilitating the passage on the road or any other road of any class of traffic (including pedestrians); and
- (c) for preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which the road run.

Duke Street/Blea Beck junction, Askam in Furness-Proposed Prohibition of Waiting and Loading At Any Time" restrictions

In response to complaints from residents, local members and the Parking Enforcement Team regarding dangerous parking and congestion at the below junction and ignoring the existing No Waiting At Any Time restriction, we are proposing to introduce No Loading /Unloading and No Waiting At Any Time restrictions on Duke Street and Blea Beck, junction in Askam in Furness due to the following reason set out in Section 1 Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984:-

- (a) for avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the road or any other road or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising, and
- (b) for facilitating the passage on the road or any other road of any class of traffic (including pedestrians)

Michaelson Road, Barrow-in-Furness Proposed to Removal of Central Long Term Parking Place

Following a request from BAE, we are proposing to remove the existing Long Term Parking place on Michaelson Road, Barrow-in-Furness to assist with the wide load movements, for the following reason set out in Section 1 Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984:-

- (a) for avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the road or any other road or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising; and
- (b) for facilitating the passage on the road or any other road of any class of traffic

(including pedestrians); and

(c) for preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which the road runs.

Thorncliffe Road, Chatsworth Street, Park Lane and Back Andover Street (2-28), Barrowin-Furness; Proposed removal part of existing No Waiting At Any Time restriction to facilitate Parking Place

Following comments from residents and businesses regarding parking availability we are proposing to remove part of the existing No Waiting At Any Time restriction to provide extra parking spaces on the named roads above, for the following reason set out in Section 1 Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984:-

- (a) for facilitating the passage on the road or any other road of any class of traffic (including pedestrians); and
- (b) for preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which the road runs

Proposed to introduce Time Limited Waiting Parking restrictions in various locations throughout Barrow in Furness.

Following comments/requests from residents and businesses regarding parking availability we are proposing to introduce Time Limited Waiting Parking restrictions to provide extra parking spaces on the named roads below, for the following reason set out in Section 1 Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984:-

- (a) for avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the road or any other road or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising; and
- (b) for facilitating the passage on the road or any other road of any class of traffic (including pedestrians); and
- (c) for preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which the road runs

Yarlside Road and Marsh Street, Barrow-in-Furness- Proposed to Introduce the Limited Waiting Parking Place Mon – Sat 8am – 6pm 2 hours no return within 4 hours (permit holders exempt).

Promenade, Barrow-in-Furness - Proposed to Introduce the Limited Waiting Parking Place Mon – Sat 8am – 6pm 1 hour no return within 2 hours.

Proposing to alter the length of existing Time Limited Waiting Parking Restrictions to accommodate formal Disabled Parking Bay in various location throughout Barrow- in-Furness

Anson Street, Barrow -in-Furness Florence Street, Barrow -in-Furness Aberdare Street, Barrow -in-Furness Anchor Road, Barrow-in-Furness Following the approval of the advisory disabled parking bays and due to the reason that they are within existing parking restrictions road we are proposing to make these formal Disabled Parking Bays within above roads, for the following reason set out in Section 1 Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984:-

- (a) for avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the road or any other road or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising; and
- (b) for facilitating the passage on the road or any other road of any class of traffic (including pedestrians); and
- (c) for preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which the road runs

Greengate Street, Barrow-in-Furness, Barrow-in-Furness- Proposed changes to the existing Time Limit Parking restriction

Following comments/requests from residents and businesses regarding parking availability we are proposing to change time limit of existing Mon – Sat 8am – 6pm 2 hours no return within 4 hours (permit holders exempt) to Limited Waiting Parking Place (At All Times) 10 mins no return within 1 hour (permit holders exempt) for the following reason set out in Section 1 Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984:-

- (a) for avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the road or any other road or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising; and
- (b) for facilitating the passage on the road or any other road of any class of traffic (including pedestrians); and
- (c) for preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which the road runs.

Ostley Bank, Barrow in Furness - Proposed Provision of Prohibition of Waiting on School Days 08:30 – 09:15 and 2:45 – 3:45 restrictions

Following requests from the school and local members regarding dangerous parking and congestion at the above location at school pick up and drop off times, we are proposing to introduce a Prohibition of Waiting on School Days 08:30 – 09:15 and 2:45 – 3:45 restriction (single yellow line) on Ostley Bank, Barrow in Furness due to the following reason set out in Section 1 Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984:-

- (a) for avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the road or any other road or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising; and
- (b) for facilitating the passage on the road or any other road of any class of traffic (including pedestrians)

Sandy Gap Lane, Barrow in Furness,-Proposed provision of Prohibition of Stopping Mon - Fri 8am – 5pm on School Keep Clear markings restriction

Following requests from the school and local members regarding dangerous and obstructive parking at the above location at school pick up and drop off times, we are proposing to introduce a Prohibition of Stopping Mon - Fri 8am – 5pm on School Keep Clear markings restriction (yellow zig-zags) on Sandy Gap Lane, Barrow in Furness outside Walney School entrance due to the following reason set out in Section 1 Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984:-

- (a) for avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the road or any other road or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising; and
- (b)for facilitating the passage on the road or any other road of any class of traffic (including pedestrians)

Yarlside Road, Barrow in Furness - Proposed to Introduce Residents Only Parking Place

Following years of requests from residents and local elected member we propose to introduce Residents Only Parking Place as well as some Time Limited Waiting and No Waiting At Any Time on part of Yarlside Road, Barrow in Furness. This is to prevent congestion and long term parking by users of the adjacent train station and to provide parking for residents on Yarlside Road, for the following reason set out in Section 1 Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984:-

- (a) for facilitating the passage on the road or any other road of any class of traffic (including pedestrians); and
- (b) for preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which the road runs

Stephen Street, Barrow in Furness -Proposed to Amend Disabled Parking Place (At All Times)

As part of the Progress on Barrow Town Centre Regeneration Scheme (pocket park), the length of the existing disabled parking space on Stephen Street, Barrow-in-Furness must be reduced to allow for the realignment of the rise table crossing. Therefore, it proposed that the length of the disabled bay be reduced from 14.5m to 10m, for the following reason set out in Section 1 Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984:-

- (a) for facilitating the passage on the road or any other road of any class of traffic (including pedestrians); and
- (b) for preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which the road runs
