Notice is hereby given that Westmorland and Furness Council after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police (and in exercise of its powers under section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended) proposes to remove and convert the existing zebra crossing located on the junction of A685 High Street where it meets U3426 Brougham Lane, Kirkby Stephen and install at the same location a puffin crossing for pedestrians and to introduce a signalised junction at the U3426 Brougham Lane, Kirkby Stephen.

The conversion from a zebra crossing to a PUFFIN type signal-controlled crossings will improve control of the flows of both pedestrians and vehicles. The existing crossing location will remain unchanged as will the controlled area extent.
