Westmorland and Furness Council propose to install single raised tables at the locations and as specified in the Schedule below.

Street Name	Town	Description
Bath Street	Barrow- in- Furness	It is proposed to install a single raised table on Bath Street junction at a point approximately 1.20m southeast of its junction with Abbey Road. The raised platform will be constructed with tarmacadam and the dimensions will be as follows: Height 50mm; Width 7.3m; Length 5.0m
Park Avenue	Barrow -in- Furness	It is proposed to install a single raised table on Park Avenue junction at a point approximately 1.20m southeast of its junction with Abbey Road. The raised platform will be constructed with tarmacadam and the dimensions will be as follows: Height 50mm; Width 9.10m; Length 5.4m.
West View Road	Barrow in Furness	It is proposed to install a single raised table on West View Road junction at a point approximately 1.20m southeast of its junction with Abbey Road. The raised platform will be constructed with tarmacadam and the dimensions will be as follows: Height 50mm; Width 7.70m; Length 6.1 m
Stafford Street	Barrow- in -Furness	It is proposed to install a single raised table on Stafford Street junction at a point approximately 1.20m southeast of its junction with Abbey Road. The raised platform will be constructed with tarmacadam and the dimensions will be as follows: Height 50mm; Width 7.70m; Length 5.3m
