

THE COUNTY OF CUMBRIA (VARIOUS ROADS, AMBLESIDE) (CONSOLIDATION
OF TRAFFIC REGULATIONS) ORDER 2023 (VARIATION NO.1 20><)

STATEMENT OF REASONS

In March 2023, through a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order (TTRO), parking restrictions were first amended on the U5540 Stockghyll Lane, Ambleside to improve traffic flow and road safety by reducing the chances of vehicles parking in an obstructive manner. These changes consisted of shortening a section of the parking bay adjacent to the rear of the Salutation Hotel. As concerns persisted, the parking bay was further shortened in September 2024, again with a TTRO.

Westmorland and Furness Council propose to make the below restrictions, shown on Drawing No. AMBSL-25-03 permanent:

- 1. Shortening of the existing 'Disc parking 10am-6pm 1 hour No return within 1 hour' parking bay by 19m*
- 2. Increasing the length of the No Waiting At Any Time (double yellow line) restrictions North and South of the above parking bay by 9m and 10m respectively in the area where the parking bay was present previously*

Westmorland and Furness Council considers that it is expedient to make the above order for the following reason (s) in Section 1(1) Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984:

- (a) for avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the road or any other road or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising, or
- (c) for facilitating the passage on the road or any other road of any class of traffic (including pedestrians), or
- (f) for preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which the road runs
