

Commons Act 2006 – Schedule 2 (7)

APPLICATION TO DEREGISTER ANY OTHER LAND WRONGLY REGISTERED AS COMMON LAND

Notice is hereby given that an application has been made by The Open Spaces Society (“the Applicant”) to Westmorland & Furness Council as commons registration authority, under Schedule 2 paragraph 4 of the Commons Act 2006 and in accordance with the Commons Registration (England) Regulations 2014.

The application relates to land known as Common Est or Common Hest, Ireleth shown outlined in red on the attached plan (“the Application Land”). The Application Land covers an area of approximately 0.8 acres.

A summary of the effect of the application is as follows: the Application Land was provisionally registered as common land on 9 September 1968 under section 4 of the Commons Registration Act 1965, pursuant to application number 141 made on 12 February 1968 by William Kitchin Calvert. An objection to the provisional registration was made by Dalton-in-Furness Urban District Council on 12 March 1971. Upon being notified of the objection, the applicant withdrew the application, and the provisional registration was cancelled by the commons registration authority on 29 June 1971. The Applicant claims that the land satisfies the criteria of paragraph 4(5) of Schedule 2 to the Commons Act 2006 and is eligible for registration as common land.

If the application is granted, the commons registration authority will give effect to the determination by registering the Application Land as common land register unit CL77, which will entail the addition of register amendment entry confirming the registration, and amendment of the register map showing the Application Land marked as registered common land.

Any person wishing to make representations:

- must quote the Application No. **CA13/46**
- must state the name and postal address of the person making them, and the nature of that person’s interest (if any) in any land affected by the application and may include an e-mail address;
- must be signed by the person making them;
- must state the grounds on which they are made; and

Any representations made will not be treated as confidential. To determine the application, it will be necessary for the commons registration authority to disclose



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information received to others, which will include the Applicant and may include other local authorities, Government Departments, public bodies, other organisations and members of the public (Data Protection Act 1998). Representations may also be disclosed upon receipt of a request for information under the Environmental Information Regulations 2004 or the Freedom of information Act 2000.

The period for making representations expires at 5pm on **5 June 2026**.

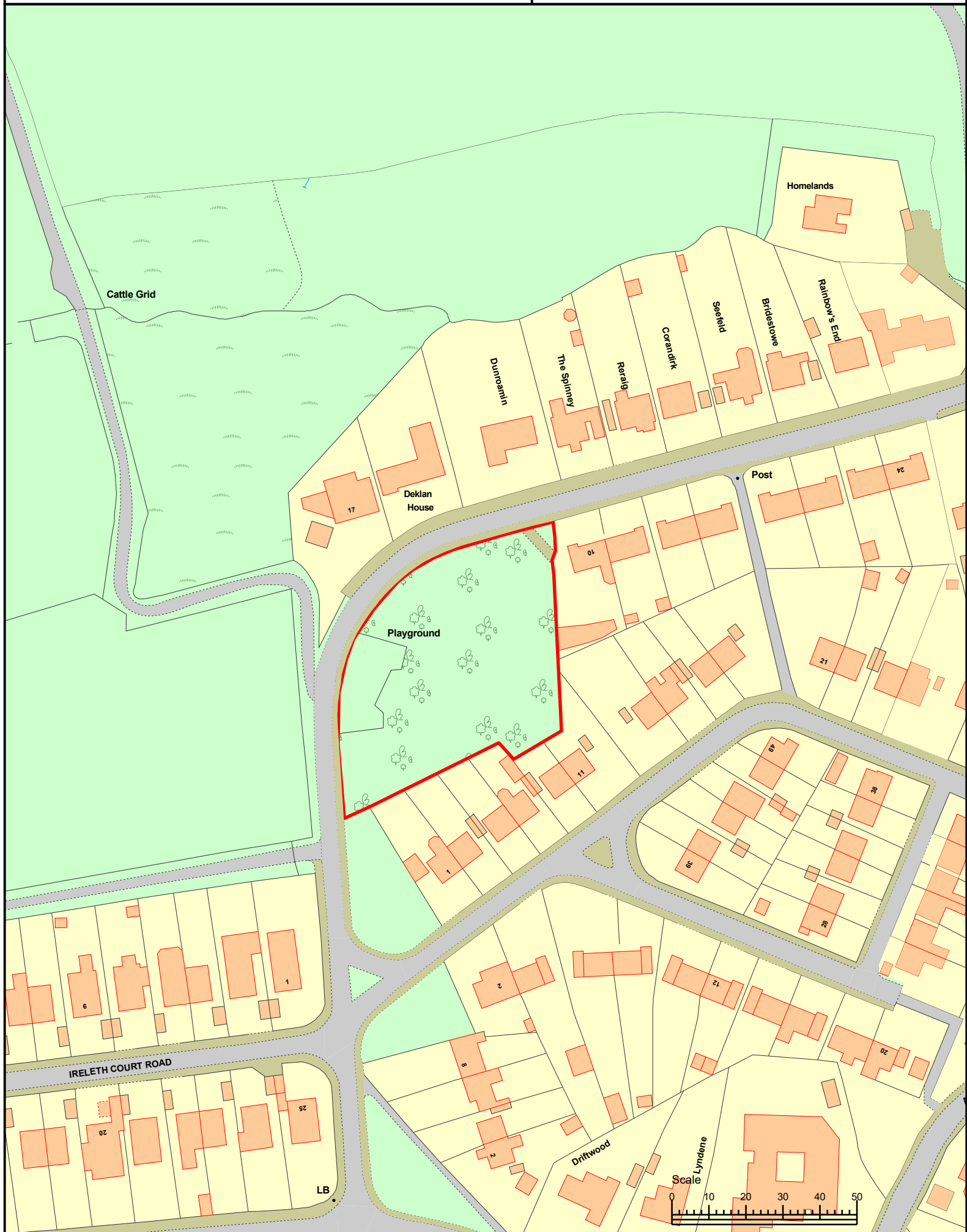
