

## Commons Act 2006 – Schedule 3 paragraph 2(2)(b)

### NOTICE OF APPLICATION TO AMEND THE REGISTER TO RECORD AN HISTORIC EVENT

Notice is hereby given that an application has been made by **Andrew Lord as personal representative of Christopher James Lord deceased** (“the Applicant”) to Westmorland & Furness Council as Commons Registration Authority, under Schedule 3 of the Commons Act 2006 and in accordance with the Commons Registration (England) Regulations 2014.

The application relates to common land register units CL17 Stainmore Regulated Pasture, North Moor, entry 33 and CL18 East Stainmore Regulated Pasture, South Moor, entry 29.

A summary of the effect of the application is as follows:

The right to graze sheep or other commonable animals to the value of 40 stints over the whole of the land comprised in this register unit together with the whole land in register unit no. CL18 (“the Right”) is currently registered as held in gross (not attached to land) at entry 33 of register unit CL17 in the names of Richard Morrison Sowerby, Richard Sowerby and David Varey Sowerby. Register unit CL18 contains the corresponding entry number 29.

The Applicant claims that the Right was transferred to Christopher James Lord and Joan Lord by way of a conveyance dated 8 March 1978. Joan Lord died in 2008 and the Right passed into Christopher James Lord’s sole ownership. Christopher James Lord died in 2009. The Applicant seeks by this application to register the above mentioned Right in his name.

If the application is granted, the Commons Registration Authority will give effect to the determination by deleting the current entries and making new entries in the register showing the Applicant as the owner of the above mentioned Right.

Any person wishing to make representations:

- must quote the Application No. **CA14/100**
- must state the name and postal address of the person making them, and the nature of that person’s interest (if any) in any land affected by the application and may include an e-mail address;
- must be signed by the person making them;
- must state the grounds on which they are made; and

Any representations made will not be treated as confidential, to determine the application it will be necessary for the commons registration authority to disclose information received to others, which will include the Applicants and may include other local authorities, Government Departments, public bodies, other organisations and members of the public (Data Protection Act 1998). Representations may also be disclosed upon receipt of a request for information under the Environmental Information Regulations 2004 or the Freedom of information Act 2000.


The period for making representations expires at 5pm on **29 May 2026**.
