APPLICATION TO AMEND THE REGISTER TO RECORD AN HISTORIC EVENT – HISTORIC TRANSFER OF A RIGHT OF COMMON

Notice of Determination

Application number CA14/100

Notice is hereby given that Westmorland & Furness Council, as the Commons Registration Authority (“the CRA”), has considered an application submitted by Andrew Lord, as personal representative of Christopher James Lord deceased (“the Applicant”).

The application relates to the right to graze sheep or other commonable animals to the value of 40 stints over the whole of the land comprised in this register unit (“the Right”) which was registered as held in gross (not attached to land) at entry 33 of register unit CL17 East Stainmore Regulated Pasture, North Moor and entry 29 of register unit CL18 East Stainmore Regulated Pasture, South Moor.

Decision

The CRA resolved to accept the application to amend the register by registering transfer of the Right to the Applicant.


Reasons

No objections were received in relation to the application. The Commons Registration Officer assessed the application and found it to be duly made under the criteria prescribed by the relevant regulations and guidance.

Outcome

The registers for CL17 East Stainmore Regulated Pasture, North Moor and CL18 East Stainmore Regulated Pasture, South Moor have been amended to show the Applicant as the owner of the Right.
