

STATUTORY DECLARATION

HIGHWAYS ACT 1980 SECTION 31 (6)

I AVERIL HAROLD DO SOLEMNLY AND SINCERELY DECLARE as follows:

1. The Woodland Trust, a company limited by guarantee and registered charity no. 294344, is and has been since 12 October 1989 the owner of the land known as Moss & Height Spring Wood, Bouth more particularly delineated on the plan accompanying this declaration and thereon edged red.
2. On the 20 February 2002 the Woodland Trust deposited with Cumbria County Council, being the appropriate Council, a statutory declaration stating that no additional ways [other than those marked in the appropriate colour on the plan accompanying this declaration] had been dedicated as footpaths since the deposit of the statement 19 September 1990.
3. No additional ways have been dedicated over the land edged red on the plan accompanying this declaration since the statutory declaration referred to in 2 above [other than those footpaths marked in the appropriate colour on the plan accompanying this declaration] and at the present time the Woodland Trust has no intention of dedicating any more public rights of way over its property.

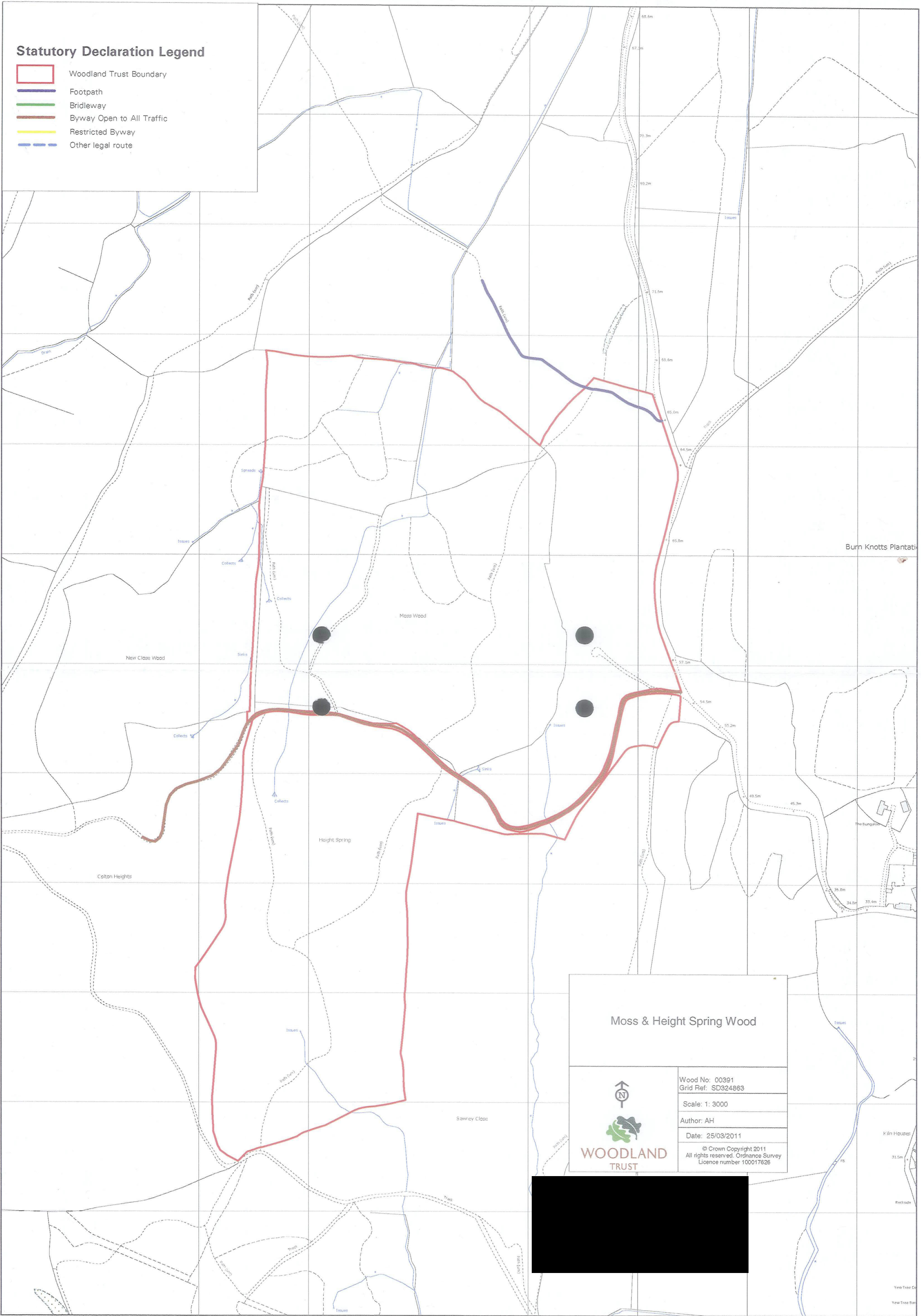
